#### **Description**

- Provide details of existing collaborative research initiatives;
- Demonstrate some form of in-kind and / or partial support for the attachment.

#### **Eligibility**

- Applicants must be PhD students in any of the participating departments listed below
- Applicants must have completed their PhD Year 1 coursework and Comprehensive Examinations

- PhD Year 1 Coursework Results
- PhD Comprehensive Exam Results
- Budget
- Work Plan for the Internship/ Experiential Learning period
- Proof of Department's Links with Host Institution
- Proof of Department's support to Candidate's Experiential Learning
- A cover letter from the Head of Department and endorsement by the Principal Supervisor
