## Shared Prosperity Forum with World Bank Group President Jim Yong Kim

The University of Ghana will host World Bank Group President Jim Yong Kim and several high level opinion leaders from the public and private sectors to reflect on two ambitious goals: 1) to end extreme poverty by 2030, and; 2) to effectively promote income growth among people in the bottom 40 percent of the population in every country of the world.
