News Release: Ghana to host African Plant Breeders Association Maiden Conference



Ghana will host the maiden conference of the African Plant Breeders Association (APBA) from October 23-25, 2019 at the University of Ghana, Legon.

The Conference which is expected to bring together over 300 scientists, researchers, national agriculture policy makers, students and professionals from both public and private sectors in the fields of plant breeding and seed science will be hosted by the West Africa Centre for Crop Improvement (WACCI) at the Auditorium of the Department of Economics, University of Ghana.

The broad objective of the conference which is to share knowledge, build partnerships, generate and publicize solutions to modernize breeding programmes for the transformation of agriculture in Africa, will also discuss a wide variety of issues impeding food security in Africa. These include accelerating genetic gain in crops, variety development and deployment, gender responsive breeding, breeding to help fight post-harvest pests and diseases, tree crop improvement, among many others.

In addition to a discussion of current research outputs and outcomes in plant breeding and seed systems, the conference will also provide opportunities for extensive collaborations targeted at achieving Sustainable Development Goal (SDG) 2 – end hunger, achieve food security, improved nutrition and promote sustainable agriculture by 2030.
