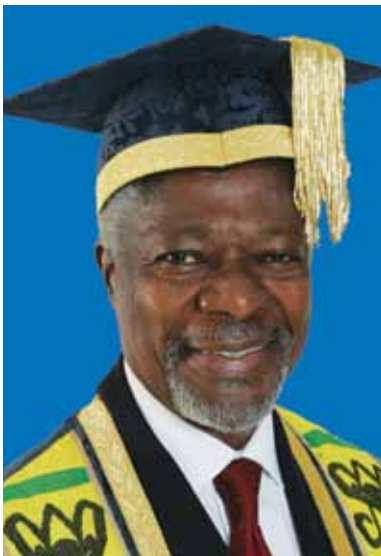

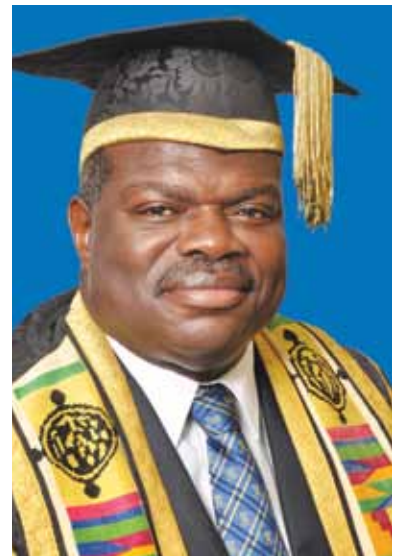

## Guest Speaker (Morning Session)



Mr. Frank Adu Jnr., an alumnus of the University of Ghana, is the Managing Director of CAL Bank Limited.

Frank enrolled at the University of Ghana in 1980 and graduated with a BA (Hons) in Geography in 1984. He later enrolled at the University of Ghana Business School, obtaining an MBA (Finance option) degree in 1989. A member of Akafo Hall during his years at the University, Frank also served as a teaching assistant to from 1984-1987.

Frank is an Investment Banker with approximately 23 years experience in the Ghanaian banking sector. He is the Chairman of the Board of Golden Beach Hotels Group, as well as the Private Sector

Development Board set up by the President of the Republic of Ghana. He is also a member of the Board of the Foundation for Orthopaedics and Complex Spines and also a member of the Investment Sub Committee of the Finance Committee of the Council of University of Ghana. Frank has co-founded a very successful international school, The Roman Ridge School and serves as the Chairman of the Board of the School. He also co-founded City Investments Company Limited, a highly successful Non-Bank Financial Institution.

He has also served on several other Boards including the National Health Insurance Council where he was its first ever Chairman and the Ghana

Stock Exchange, where he was Chairman for 4 years. Frank was instrumental in constructing a near 7000 bed hostel block for the University which effectively solved the problem of inadequate accommodation for the University of Ghana.

Frank's mentors several young people and is an active Patron of Waves International, a group of graduate students of the University and undergraduates who seek to progress professionally and make a positive impact on our society. As a member of the Ghana Angel Investor Network (GAIN) Frank invests in business ideas of young entrepreneurs who otherwise have no access to equity or debt financing.

## Guest Speaker (Afternoon Session)



Mr. Ace Anan Ankomah, Managing Partner, Bentsi-Enchill, Letsa & Ankomah, is an alumnus of the University of Ghana. He enrolled at the University of Ghana in 1987 and obtained a Bachelor of Laws degree in 1990. He was called to the Bar in 1992.

Ace was a teaching and research assistant at the University of Ghana from 1992-1993 where he assisted in teaching and research in Criminal Law, Torts and Commercial Law at the Faculty of Law and the University of Ghana Business School)

He enrolled at Queen's University, Kingston, in Ontario, Canada in 1993, obtaining a Master of

Laws (LLM) degree in International Taxation in 1994, serving also as a Research Assistant at the Faculty of Law. Upon his return, Ace was first appointed Lecturer in Company Law at the University of Ghana Business School, from 1997-2003, and later appointed Senior Lecturer (Civil Procedure at the Ghana School of Law ) from 2005-2012.

Ace, who heads the Litigation Department, has been Managing Partner at Bentsi-Enchill, Letsa & Ankomah from 2010 to date, and has high levels of expertise in tax and corporate litigation, and market sources describe him as a '... brilliant trial lawyer

who impresses with his thorough preparation and great delivery in court."

Ace is a Member of the Legal Committee and Legal Aid Committee, Ghana Bar Association, and also serves as a Member of the International Court of Arbitration of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC). He was appointed Member of the Advisory Board of Millicom International Cellular SA, for Millicom Ghana Ltd from this year, and Regional Vice-Chair for Europe/Middle East/Africa, Lex Mundi Managing Partners Committee.

## While you were here: 2009–2013

### 2009

- The University's ICT-based Distance Education Project, sponsored by the Government of Ghana through a concessionary loan from the People's Republic of China was launched. The project is geared towards improving upon the quality of teaching, learning and research through the introduction of an e-learning system.

### 2010

- The University made changes to the requirements for graduation in content and structure, introducing critical thinking, logic and behaviourism to instill critical thinking in students' life and mode of analysis.

### 2011

- University of Ghana makes changes in re-opening schedule to accommodate candidates who wrote their entrance

examinations in May/June 2011 to allow successful applicants to enter the University in the same year rather than having to wait for a year as is usually the case. This arose partly because the WASSCE was not written in June due to the change from a 3-year to a 4-year Senior High School education.

### 2012

- The pioneer class of the Distance Education programme graduated. The University's Distance Education Programme officially was launched in the 2007/8 academic year to widen access to all qualified applicants irrespective of family, social commitments or geographical background.
- University approves a new structure for PhD programmes in line with international best practices. The new structure will allow

the admission of first degree holders into the MPhil/PhD programmes, the introduction of comprehensive examinations, the introduction of compulsory course work and the formal defense of research proposals.

- Inauguration of Carnegie-sponsored Research Commons at the University's Balme Library.

### 2013

- In line with the programme to enhance teaching and research, the University has acquired scientific equipment awaiting installation. A Smart X2S Automated System at the Department of Chemistry; An X-Ray Diffractometer at the Department of Physics; a High Performance Liquid Chromatograph (HPLC) to the Department of Biochemistry, Cell and Molecular Biology.

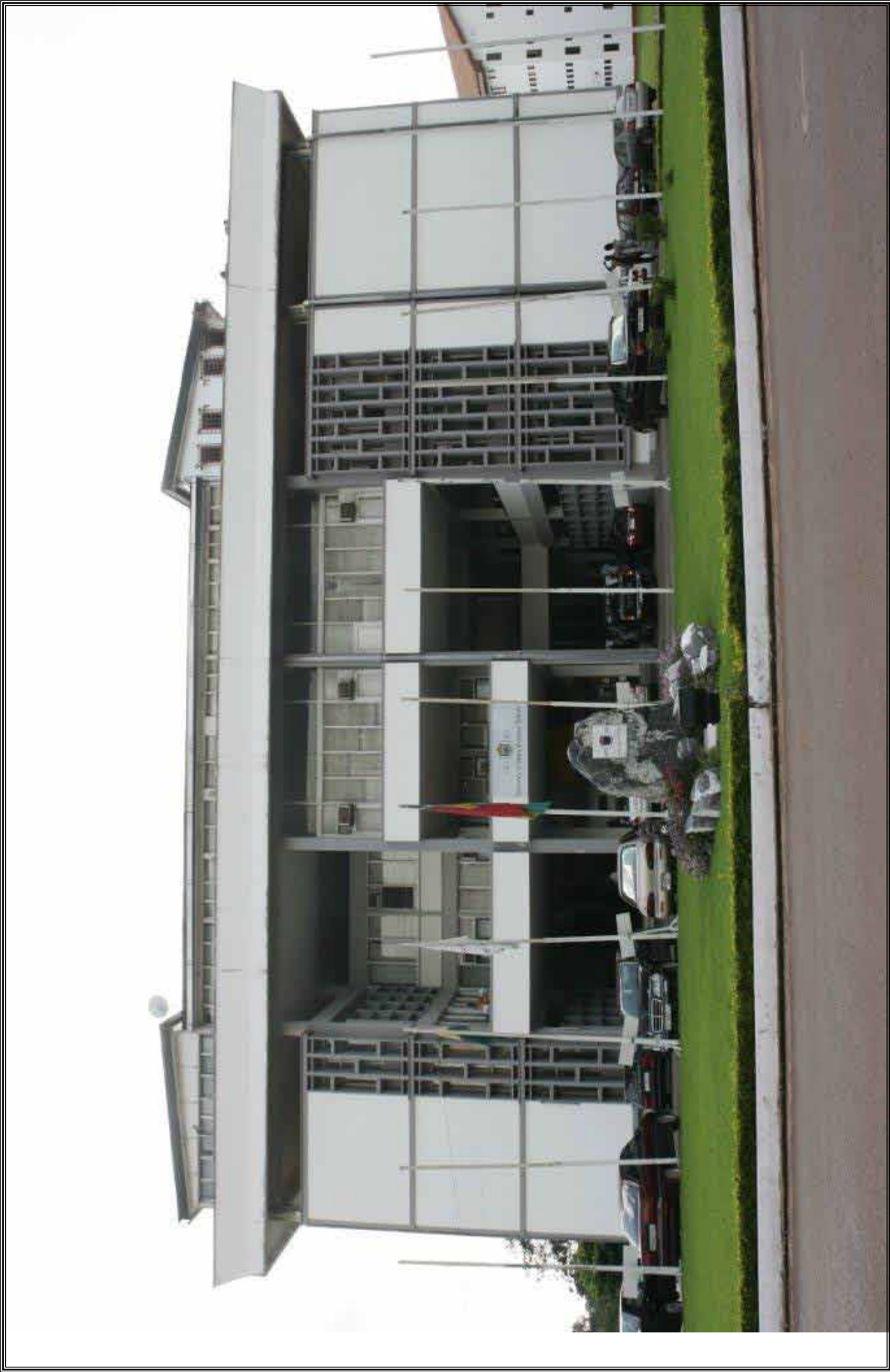
