The Africa Climate Collaborative Project at the University of Ghana is a climate resilience and sustainability research and capacity-building initiative aimed at empowering young people, especially women, refugees/displaced youth, and people with disabilities, in West Africa to conduct cutting-edge research, lead climate-resilient development, and foster green economic growth.

As part of its commitment to empowering young people, the project is inviting applications for prospective national service persons for the 2026/2027 academic year to contribute to the work of the project while gaining valuable hands-on experience.

We welcome applications from final year undergraduate students from universities in Ghana with academic backgrounds or skill sets in the following areas:

1. Data Analytics/Mathematics/Statistics
2. Geography
3. Computer Science/Computer Engineering
4. Finance/Accounting
5. Procurement/Logistics
6. Languages
7. Social Sciences
8. Environmental Sciences
9. Communications/Journalism/Website and social media content creation and management

Applicants should also demonstrate:

1. Proficiency in Microsoft Word, Excel, and PowerPoint.
2. Strong organisational and communication skills.
3. Ability to work independently and collaboratively in a team environment.
4. A genuine interest in climate change and sustainability.

Interested final year students who have registered for national service for the 2026/2027 academic year should submit the following documents as **a single PDF** file saved with the applicant's full name to accapplications@ug.edu.gh. Applicants should use "**Graduate Intern Application 2026/2027**" as the subject of the email.

1. An application letter (**one page**) stating why you should be considered for the role
2. Academic transcript
3. Current CV
4. Copy of Student ID

Shortlisted applicants will be required to participate in a brief interaction as part of the selection process.
