Vacancy for National Service Person

Duties

- Guide students on writing and assignments.
- Proofread manuscripts with the supervision of a fellow at the centre.
- Actively participate in training sessions for staff of the centre.
- Assist with the training of new interns and volunteers.
- Collaborate with writing centre staff to create resources on writing.
- Provide support for special programmes.
- Provide administrative support.

Eligibility

- Must have a 3:00 FGPA or higher.
- Must have majored in the humanities. Students of English, Linguistics and Modern Languages are especially encouraged to apply.
- Must have a strong interest in writing and communication.
- Must be computer literate.
- Must have strong professional and social skills

Requirements for Application

- An application letter.
- A 500-word statement on why you wish to work in the writing centre.
- Updated curriculum vitae.
- Current academic transcript.
- Contact details (email and telephone numbers) of two referees.
- Applicants telephone number (preferable a WhatsApp line) and NSS pin code.
